The New York State Law that entitles all employees to take up to four hours of paid leave annually, without charge to leave credits, for prostate and breast cancer screening has been expanded to cover all cancer screenings. Travel time is included in the four-hour cap. Absence beyond the four hours must be charged to leave credits. The leave is not cumulative and expires at the close of business of the last day of each fiscal year.
